**By Subway:** Take the L train to the Grand Street stop. From the exit walk one block east of Bushwick Avenue (past the school) on Grand Street. Look for the NURTUREart banner just after the traffic light at Waterbury Street.

**Driving From Manhattan:** Williamsburg Bridge, stay in outside lane, Broadway / S. 5 St exit. Turn left at light onto Havemeyer St. Turn right next light onto Borinquen Place, continue straight, street will change name to Grand Street. Continue approx. a half mile—pass Bushwick Avenue—after next traffic light at Waterbury Street look for the NURTUREart banner on the right.
